The work in São Camilo is especially difficult as it is an area overcome with drugs and dire poverty. Most of the outreach to that community is done through VBS with the children and meeting with their families.

In Santa Gertrudes and Novo Horizonte we will be going door to door telling people about Jesus. We will also be doing dramas and presenting the Gospel in plazas and other larger areas where people gather.

As we go to these places we will be accompanied by the youth group of Comunidade Cristã Missionária (Christian Missionary Community). Many of them will be our translators, some of them helpers and guides. Please pray for their youth and church as they participate with us.
